DESCRIPTION

A postdoctoral position is available with Dr. Pavithra Viswanath and Dr. Sabrina Ronen at the University of California San Francisco (UCSF) Department of Radiology and Biomedical Imaging. The focus of the laboratory is to leverage an understanding of brain tumor metabolism for the identification of novel metabolic biomarkers and therapeutic targets. The postdoctoral scholar will work on elucidating the molecular and metabolic underpinnings of oncogenic events in brain tumors using isogenic cell lines, neurosphere cultures, and various genetically engineered and patient-derived orthotopic rodent models.

QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal candidate should have a strong publication record and expertise in delineating cancer metabolism using liquid chromatography-mass spectrometry (LC-MS-MS) and gas chromatography-mass spectrometry (GC-MS). We are a highly collaborative group, and the candidate should be able to work independently as well as in a team. The candidate will be required to present their data on a regular basis and should have excellent oral and written communication skills.

We are interested in applicants from diverse backgrounds with a PhD or MD/PhD in cancer and cell biology, metabolism, and biochemistry.
