





PARKING (rates as of January 2017)

**Street Parking** all parking regulations are enforced on Saturdays. Limited street parking (without meters) may be available around the campus, metered and two-hour parking are also available.

Laurel Heights Campus Surface Lot in the northeast above-ground section. A self-serve machine (credit/debit cards) is located on the east side of this public parking section. Be sure to place the receipt on your windshield so you do not get a ticket. Public parking rate on Saturday is \$6 for from 7 am - 6 pm; note you cannot purchase the ticket prior to 6:59 am. 55 spaces available.
