Course Overview

This course, featuring the breadth and depth of UCSF Radiology expertise in all subspecialties, is designed for practicing radiologists in the community, and covers fundamentals and pitfalls of state-of-the-art imaging, as well as hot-topics in short, focused sessions. This five-day course is designed to present a complete review of all systems and modalities for the general radiologist. A focus of the course will be appropriate imaging technique and utilization.

The American College of Radiology (ACR) issues imaging guidelines for a variety of cancers, such as BI-RADS for breast Imaging, and LI-RADS for liver imaging. Successful implementation of these guidelines requires radiology providers to be familiar with the imaging findings, the proper nomenclature, and the latest acquisition technique. The integration of these updates and protocols will be discussed and reinforced at this conference.

At the completion of the course, the attendee should be able to understand and apply:

1. Current guidelines and protocols for cancer imaging, with focus on breast, colon, endometrium, liver, lung, prostate and pediatrics;
2. Up-to-date imaging approaches to trauma and emergency conditions of the brain and spine;
3. Imaging pearls and pitfalls in joint injuries of the shoulder, elbow and knee;
4. Fundamentals and criteria for imaging of women and children.

This course will offer 25 Self-Assessment credits (pending approval and subject to change):

6.0 in Abdominal, 3.0 in Breast, 3.0 in Musculoskeletal, 3.5 in Neuro, 3.5 in Pediatrics, 3.0 in Thoracic and 3.0 in Ultrasound.

The Napa Valley is centrally located in the inland area just east of the coastal region. Located along Highway 29 (St Helena Hwy) traveling north from downtown Napa are the towns of Yountville, St Helena and Calistoga, each of which are home to several wineries, as well as a wonderful mix of crafts shops, restaurants, destination spas, farmers markets, shopping, golf and other recreational activities. 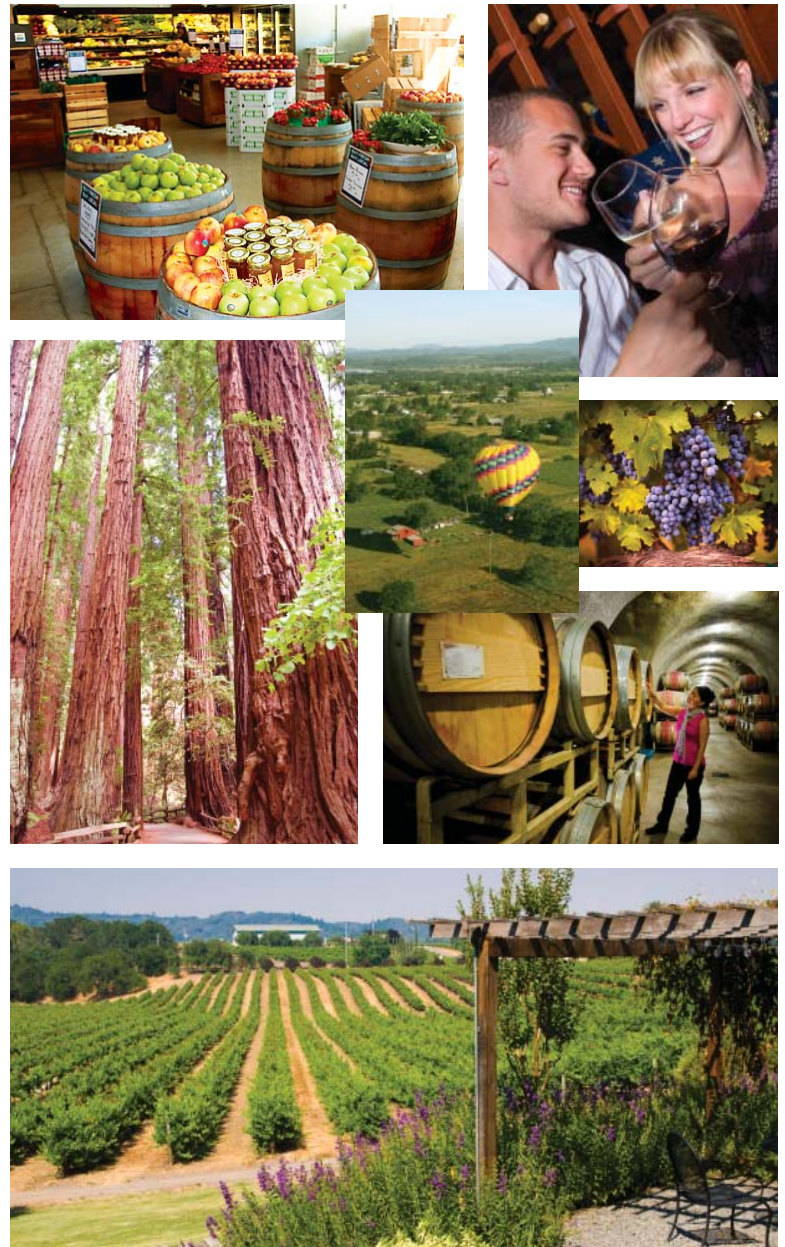

The city of Napa, founded in 1847, was originally settled due to its strategic location for travel and commerce along the inland river route. The historic Napa Mill is the home for the Napa General Store, as well as a collection of unique restaurants, shops and a day spa. Artisan shops offer locally grown foods including olive oils, jams, tapenades and mustards. There several tasting rooms all within walking distance.

Cultural venues include the Napa Valley Opera House and art-deco Uptown Theatre, which are home to live music, theatre, comedy and jazz. The downtown area includes a number of upscale galleries including the Di Rosa and the Hess Collection. The Fireman's Museum, Scientopia and Rockzilla will keep kids of all ages busy.

There are three scenic parks which provide endless opportunities for hiking and taking photos. With the temperate weather and fall colors, bicycle rentals at this time of year are particularly rewarding.

The downtown area is also the starting point for the popular Napa Valley Wine Train, which allows one to relax and take in all the sights and scenic beauty without having to keep your eyes on the road.
