This three-day course is intended for practicing clinical radiologists in both general and subspecialty practice, as well as those working in an academic environment, to review and address important topics in brain, spine, gastrointestinal, genitourinary, pulmonary, oncologic, vascular and ob-gyn imaging.

The focus of this course will be on practical applications of body, cardiothoracic, and neuro imaging, with a focus on recent updates to guidelines (i.e. PI-RADS, TI-RADS, Fleischner Guidelines), and a review of commonly encountered diseases and their mimics. Highlights will include: updates on essential spinal disease and spinal cord-imaging, current updates on the management of thyroid nodules on ultrasound, an in-depth review of HRCT of the lung, a review of the updated Fleischner Guidelines for lung nodule management, the most recent version of PI-RADS, and management of common and incidental pancreatic and adrenal masses.

There will be ample opportunity for interaction between faculty and attendees.

Upon completion of this course, the attendee should be able to:

- Differentiate various abnormalities of the abdomen & pelvis using CT, MRI and Ultrasound;
- 2. Recognize typical and atypical appearances of lung cancer;
- 3. Describe the proper management of renal carcinomas;
- 4. Evaluate the adnexa and uterus in patients with abdominal pain and other symptoms;
- 5. Utilize ultrasound to assess thyroid nodules;
- 6. Recognize normal and abnormal appearances after bariatric surgery;
- 7. Interpret musculoskeletal ultrasound;
- 8. Differentiate brain tumors from tumor mimics.

### Self-Assessment (SAM)

This course will offer 16.0 Self-Assessment credits (pending approval and subject to change): 4.25 in Abdominal, 3.25 in Neuro, 4.5 in Thoracic, and 4.0 in Ultrasound.


