Images can be viewed or downloaded from anywhere on the internet including your home and physician offices.

- 1. Log into MyChart https://ucsfmychart.ucsfmedicalcenter.org/
- 2. Open Test Results



- 3. Scroll to the study that you're interested in viewing or downloading
- 4. Click on the study and scroll to the bottom

- 6. Click the Download DICOM icon on the toolbar to download the imaging exam.

- 8. Your device will download a single archive file (.zip) that contains all the images from your study. This .zip file can be saved on your computer or a storage provider like iCloud, Dropbox, Google Drive, or Box.
- 9. If you're sharing these files with another provider or facility, follow their uploading instructions.
